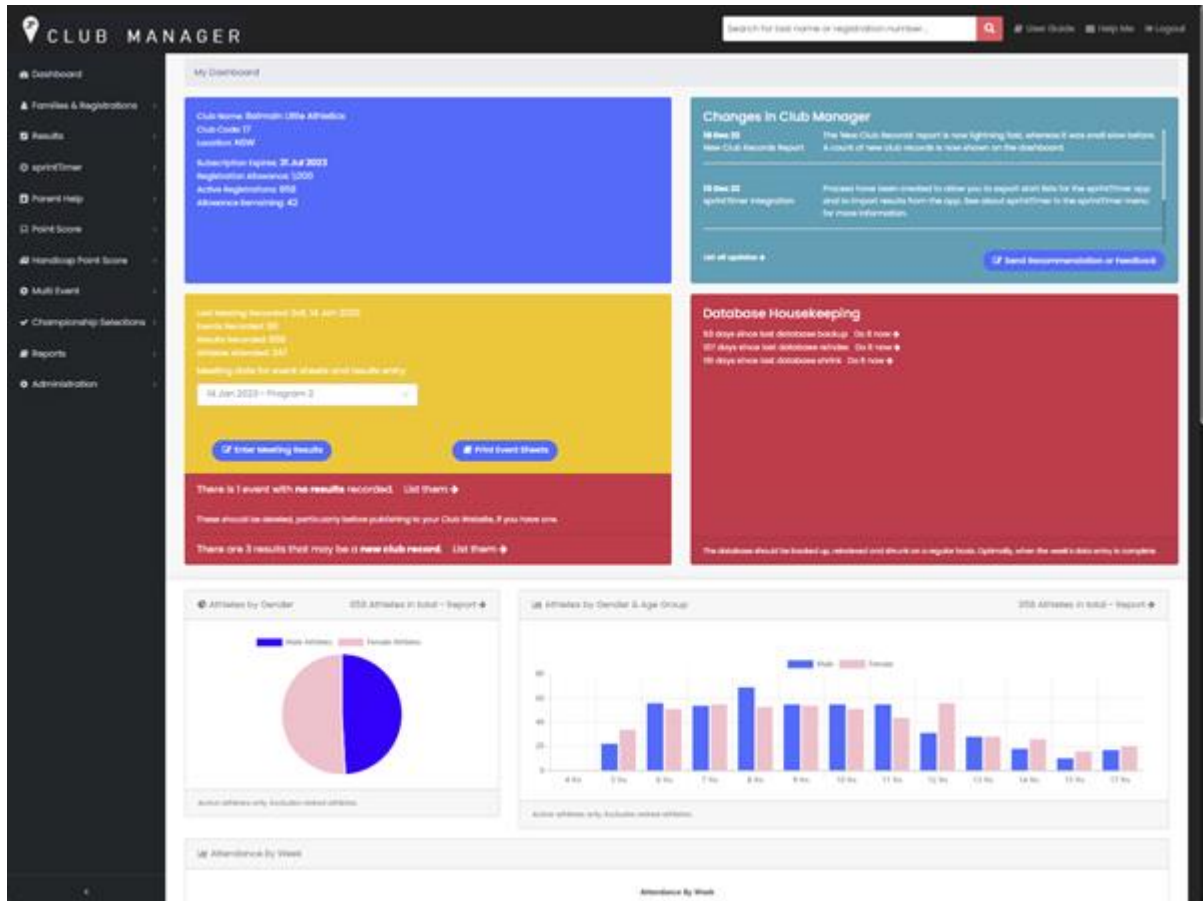

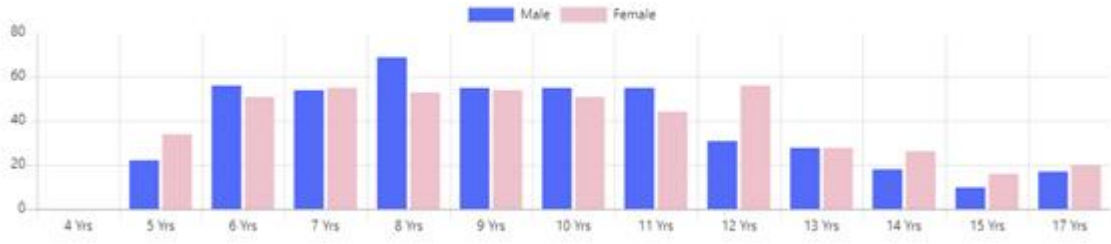

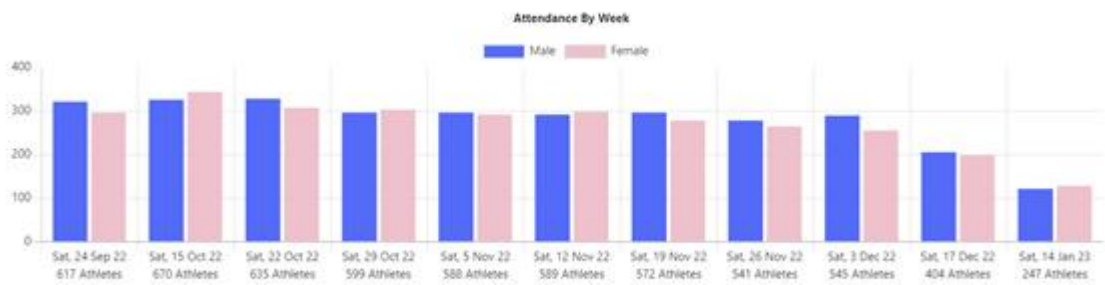
Athletes by Gender & Age Group

Attendance By Week



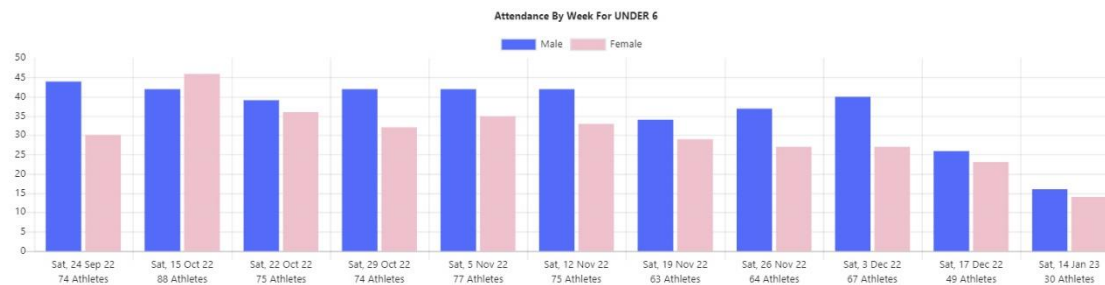

Managing Registrations in Club Manager

Keeping Track of Registrations Is a Breeze In Club Manager

It all starts with registrations, so if they're not right, nothing will be. With this in mind, Club Manager is designed to encompass as much or as little registration information as you require. At the same time data entry is **a breeze**. Registrations are tied to families so that updating a family record can also update the attached registrations for you. Registration numbers are kept unique in Club Manager for you.

Even better, Club Manager will let you download your registrations from **GameDay** so you don't have to key them all in.

So no matter how you prefer to maintain your critical registration data, Club Manager will keep it right.

Result Recording Sheets in Club Manager

Including Athlete PBs & Centre Records and Season Best

An integral part of running Little Athletics clubs, small or large, is the recording of results. Recording results in Club Manager is **a cinch when you use the event sheets** in Club Manager. You print them out for the selected week, fill them in and then key them into Club Manager.

Recognising that clubs have various requirements for managing their result recording efforts, Club Manager provides **4 versions** of Event Sheets:

The first version is '**Event Sheets by Age Group, Gender and Event**'. This option will page break on each of these. Some may find this a waste of paper so other options are available.

Some clubs have the age managers take the recording sheets with them and so use the second option, '**Event Sheets by Age Group**'.

Others have the sheets at each event and so use the first option 'Event Sheets' or to save paper the third option, '**Event Sheets by Event**'.

The fourth option, '**Event Sheets Brief**' is similar to the 'Event Sheets by Age Group' except it has the events going across the page rather than down the page. This saves even more paper.

All version of the result recording sheets will display club records and season best performance for the event, along with the season PB for each athlete.



Entering Results in Club Manager

Club Manager, Quick & Easy to Enter Results, Even in Real Time

Club Manager results entry has been developed with ease of use, intuitive process, accuracy and integrity, and minimal training the primary goals. The results entry process can be easily performed by parent helpers with minimal training. That way you can have devices out on the field during competition for recording results. Alternatively, you can have several laptops at the amenities with parent helpers entering results as the result sheets come in.

Some clubs have the age group managers enter the results for their age group on the fly or when they get home. That way the recorder doesn't have to spend hours at home entering results. Some club have the results available on their web site during or soon after completion is complete for the day.

Results can be **entered quickly**, only requiring the entry of registration number and result from event sheets. Results can be **entered live** (requiring internet and device) or later from events sheets printed from Club Manager.

The result entry page displays the current club record and season best performance for the result. If achievement levels are specified, these will also be disclosed for the event and each result.

The process is by way of selecting the age group, gender and event and then keying in the registration number, press enter, then key the result and press enter. The result is saved, and a new result box presented. No need to use the mouse to navigate to the save button!

As each result is saved:

- checks will be made on the registration number for correct age group and gender for the event. In this case results are not saved
- checks will be made on the result for new club record and if performance within 20% of PB. These are warnings to help with data integrity
- the PB for that athlete and the place for the result is displayed.

Results can also be entered on complete listing of athletes in the selected age group and gender. In this case, all you do is enter the result, or a period to skip an athlete that did not compete, or 0 to indicate they did not finish. The athletes are listed in the same order as the event sheets making the result entry process a breeze and lightning fast. All you do is enter the result and press enter to go to the next.

Club Manager provides a swag of reports and features to help you analyse your results to help with Championship selections.

No need to enter data into an Excel file to maintain your point score system. It's all done for you in Club Manager. However, if you like to get into Excel you can also download your results and other data to csv for import into Excel for manipulation.

Trying to come to terms with fair selection for Zone Championships can take time. Especially in a large club when spots are limited. Club Manager can analyse your results for each event to rank athletes. You can even make selections and validate and report. Selections can then be exported to produce a file compatible with Meet Manager.

Point Score and Awards in Club Manager

Club Manager offers a point score system that will meet your needs. It is a straight-forward system whereby points can be set to be awarded:

- for attendance when a result is recorded
- for PB or equal PB
- for place in event - for heat, club within club, and overall
- for special points for championship attendance etc

Points can be set for each aspect. If you only want to award points for the first three places you can simply leave place 4 to 7 as zero.

If you run a handicap day you can use the point score system to ascertain awards for the day.

Running a simple point score like this takes away the burden for the event manager and age managers. A simple point score makes it easy to support award decisions and explain point score and awards it to parents and athletes.

The point score can be calculated and used for analysis during the season.

If you're into a more complex point score system you can export your results from Club Manager and import them into Excel for manipulation.

A point score report can be generated:

- for all or selected age groups and genders.
- for all or selected event types
- for totals points, for attendance, or place
- for sort by Total Points, PB points, place or name

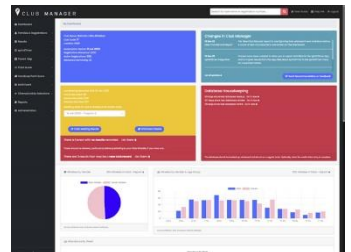

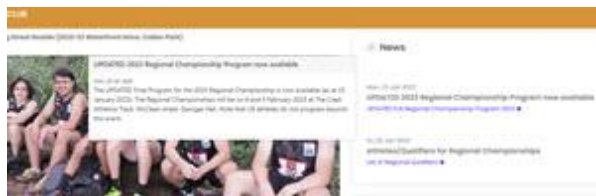

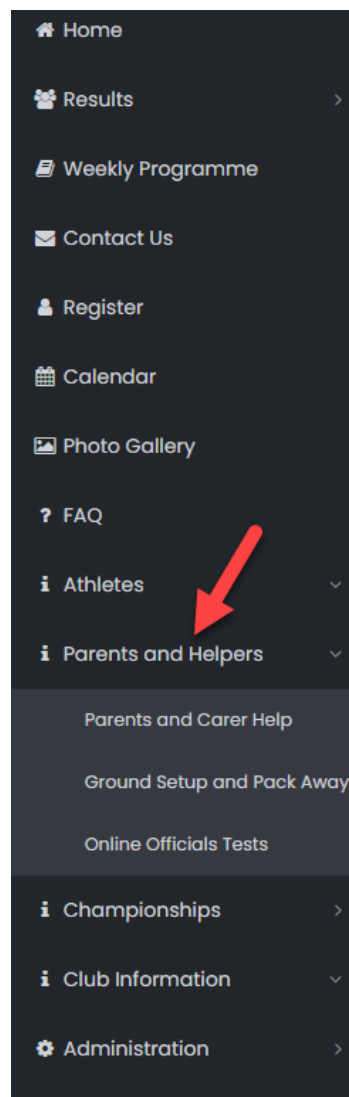

When editing, or creating a page, you can specify its group membership. Allowing you to completely restructure your menu when required, such as when your site content grows. You can also change the page's title as it appears in the site menu and the heading of the page.

You can have a specific access level for each page. Level 0 for access by all site visitors and 1 to 9 for those who sign in. You can create any number users as you need and specify an access level for each. In that way committee members can sign in and access pages they need. Whereas age managers can sign in and get access to information they require without having access to committee information. **This avoids loss of information when club officials move on.**

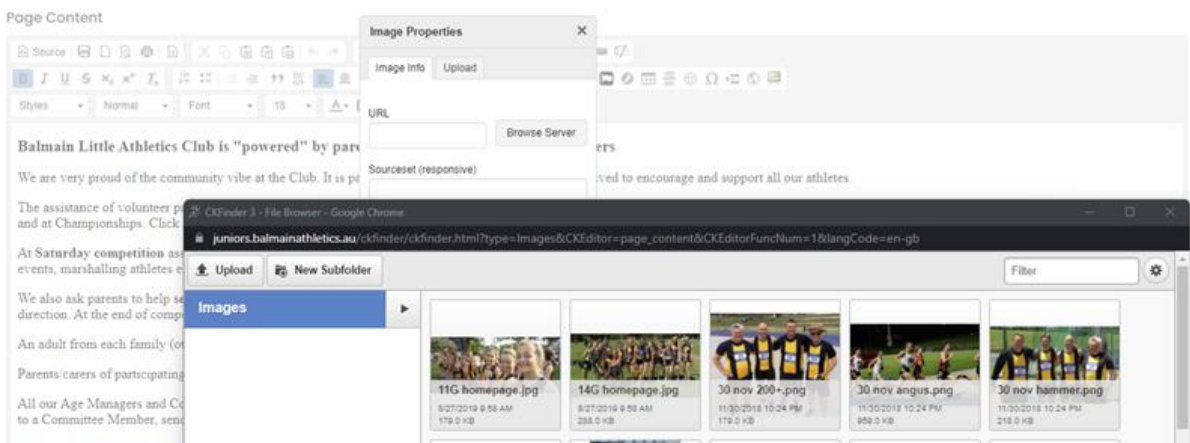

VP & IT OFFICER MANLY WARRINGAH LITTLE ATHLETICS

My name is Darryl Welch. I am the Vice President and IT Officer for Manly Warringah Little Athletics Centre. Manly is one of the oldest and largest Little Athletics Centres in NSW and is made up of 6 clubs that compete against each other each Saturday at Narrabeen.

Previously we used a system at Manly which is commonly used within centres to store athletes' information and to record results.

There were a number of difficulties that we had with it and found it to be largely unsupported. As a result we looked into what other options we had which is how I came across Club Manager.

Based on the functionality and abilities in Club Manager, and its integration with our Club Website (the web site and hosting package available), myself and the Manly committee found it very easy to make the decision that Club Manager is perfect for our Little Athletics Centre. As a result we bought it and are now using it.

Working for a software company myself, I had expectations that there would be a number of teething problems with the software both in downloading and inserting registration data from Clubs On-Line, registering people in Club Manager that showed up on the morning of competition, and in entering results.

Much to my pleasant surprise, there have been no issues with the software that caused any sort of disruption to us. Our first day of competition was last Saturday (20/9/08) and everyone involved in the running of the competition as well as the club registrars commented on how smooth it went. As well as this, due to some of the features in Club Manager it actually cuts down on the work required by a number of our track and field officials which everyone was most happy about. We have had issues with getting enough parents to assist in the running of competition so anything that makes life easier is a huge advantage.

I am not sure what other packages you are looking at, or that are out there, I can only compare Club Manager to the system that we use to use.

Based on this, we were convinced to use Club Manager for the following reasons:

It is browser based, not an application that needs to be installed on each PC. This means that we can easily use any laptop (or PC) out in the field to enter results (with a wireless network). Our objective is to have each age manager with their own laptop to enter the results in as the athlete completes their turn. This will cut down on the need for parent

helpers to sit in a room to enter data and, more importantly, it gives the children real time feedback on if they have achieved a PB. We try and encourage children to be their best and being able to tell them immediately if they have achieved a PB will really help to reinforce this.

It is so easy to use. On Saturday we had a grandmother of one of the athletes entering data after reading a brief instruction sheet.

It is very easy to set up and configure. You do not need any real computer skills to set it up and administer it on a day to day basis. It is very intuitive and straight forward. If you have used a PC and have very basic computer skills then you can look after it.

It has very good validation to ensure that results are recorded correctly. While human error is always possible, Club Manager cuts this down dramatically though the validation of data that it has. It stops people entering data for wrong events, age groups etc.

It is able to easily accept the registration from Clubs On-Line as well as having the ability to register people directly into Club Manager (e.g. at registration days where there is no internet connection to Clubs On-Line) then upload the data to Clubs On-line.

Manly has a very complicated points scoring system with different awards for clubs and the centre which are all calculated differently. Club Manager was easily able to accommodate what we required without us having to change the way that we do things. This was a major concern that we had. We didn't want the software to dictate the way that we had to do things, the software had to be able to do things the way we have always done things. It did.

It keeps track of parent duties performed. We have for many years had difficulties in tracking which parents have helped on competition days. We continually had the same people doing work while others did nothing. It was a real problem for us. With Club Manager we are able to easily track this to ensure that everyone does their fair share which should help competition days run smoother.

Club Manager has been developed specifically for the way that Little Athletics is run in NSW so is a perfect fit for the way that things are done. I am always weary of "generic" software of this type that is modified to support other ways of doing things. As I mentioned before, I work for a software company and know the issues that this sort of thing causes for support and changes in the future.

The support from the supplier has been excellent and fast. I have had numerous questions and requested a number of small changes to accommodate different things that we wanted to see in the software. The supplier has always responded promptly and gone out of his

way to accommodate us. Having one of the largest little athletics centres in NSW it is critical that I know that we can rely on fast and efficient support if needed.

It can create many reports to give crucial information such as medical information for children, championship/representative selection reports, registration information etc. This will make life so much easier for us and with things like championship/representative selection, take out any controversy or subjectiveness.

The integration with eClub Manager which we use for our web site is fantastic, especially the ability for the children to view their results on-line. Children use to have to wait for 2 weeks to get their results and the administrative headache of getting the printed results to so many children was a real pain. Now it is so simple to upload the results. As I mentioned before we have only had 1 competition day and since then we have had so much positive feedback on children being able to see their results.

It is very pleasing and gives me real comfort that we made the right decision.

There are more benefits of Club Manager that I could go through, but I think you get the idea.

I can highly recommend Club Manager and believe that you should seriously look at it as part of your investigations. It has so many good points and makes life so much easier for a little athletics centre.”
